Cecilia & Garrett Boone have improved the lives of Texans by advancing equity for women and girls, improving educational outcomes for children in public schools, and promoting environmental stewardship. Cecilia is the past chair of the Dallas Women's Foundation, Planned Parenthood Federation of America, and Girls Inc. of Metropolitan Dallas, among other organizations. Garrett is cofounder and Chairman Emeritus of The Container Store, which he launched with his partners in 1978 and became one of the most successful businesses in Texas. He has been a leading business voice in advocating for a sustainable environment, co-founding the Texas Business for Clean Air Foundation in 2006.
