TEXANS REJECT STATE INTERFERENCE

Texans DO NOT WANT state legislators interfering with their local governments.

A strong majority disapprove of state legislatures passing laws that leave local communities powerless to advance their local economy or protect workers.

Poll conducted by Baselice & Associates, Inc. of 801 registered voters that participated in the last election across Texas. Half of those polled were via cell phone and the other half on landlines between February 13-19, 2019. Poll results represent a 95% confidence level with a +/-3.5 margin of error.
