Garrett Boone is co-founder and Chairman Emeritus of The Container Store, which he launched with his partners in 1978 and which became one of the most successful businesses in Texas. He has been a leading business voice in advocating for a sustainable environment, co-founding the Texas Business for Clean Air Foundation in 2006. Garrett has been a pioneer in increasing green space and park land in Dallas, serving on a

number of boards relating to the development of parks along the Trinity River. The Dallas Morning News selected Garrett as a 2007 Texan of the Year finalist.

With their children, Cecilia and Garrett founded The Boone Family Foundation in 2008 to be a resource for social justice. They work to challenge the status quo, supporting organizations and programs that make communities more fair and just for all people.
